Re: Bulk Service Collection changes

Commissioners,

In an effort to curb and discourage illegal dumping, and to increase service efficiency to city residents, the Department of Public Service Division of Refuse Collection has enacted minor changes to our bulk service collection.

For reference, City Code 1301.06 defines bulk refuse as "items which are acceptable waste, with the exclusion of yard waste, that require special collection arrangements due to size, weight or shape including but not limited to carpet, appliances, furniture, mattresses, or box springs." (Ord. 3038-97)

These enacted changes include the following:

- Bags, boxes, storage tubs, luggage and/or open containers that are filled with trash will not be collected
- 2. Empty storage tubs, luggage, as well as plastic or metal trash containers/cans **will** be collected
- 3. Empty boxes should be broken down and placed out for the resident's scheduled curbside recycling
- 4. Bags and/or boxes of trash must be placed inside the resident's designated refuse container
- 5. Carpet from multi-family units (5 or more units) will not be collected

Further, it is important to remind residents that items placed out for collection as a result of an eviction, set-out, or foreclosure are not eligible for bulk survice collection. For private collections, residents should refer to the Franklin County Board of Health website for a list of licensed haulers
