|  | <p><b>Special CAC Capital Budget meeting</b> – Chair Boulton</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Directive from city council: “Columbus City Council's goal is to highlight neighborhood priorities to City Departments as they work on their capital improvement budgets this year and their investments in future years (i.e., five-year capital improvement plan). Capital projects relate to physical assets such as roads, sewers and water infrastructure, parkland, fire stations, and much more. We know these capital investments are vital for supporting residents’ quality of life and our local economy, and for this reason, the city sets aside a quarter of every dollar collected in City income tax to finance them. However, these investments do only their highest good when they align with residents’ needs, which is why we hope you'll share input on the capital needs in your area commission area of Columbus using this form.”</li><li>• Presentation from Eliza Pendexter, chair Planning and Development Committee, with recommendations for the capital budget, including:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ High Street Study to improve pedestrian safety</li><li>○ Indianola Avenue shared use path north of Morse Road</li><li>○ Whetstone Community Center improvements</li><li>○ Demonstration projects, for example, east-west bike connection on North Broadway</li><li>○ Improve existing crosswalks in various locations.</li></ul></li><li>• Questions from commissioners about asking the city for design studies instead of implementation of the project, separate bike path versus bike lanes, lower speeds and running lights on streets in Clintonville, sidewalk gaps on Indianola, jurisdiction of freeway overpasses for east-west connection.</li><li>• Presentation from Ryan Foshee, co-chair Clintonville Greenspot Committee about different parks in Clintonville and MORPC Central Ohio Greenways.</li><li>• Question from commissioners about stairs and other issues in Glen Echo Park.</li><li>• Discussion of order of priorities among commissioners and committee chairs.</li><li>• The capital budget priorities submitted to City Council are the following:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1.
